1. Pursuant to the Division of Purchases and Supply, Agency Procurement and Surplus Property Manual, Chapter 14, Electronic Procurement, Section 14.9, Use of eVA and Exclusions, b., 14. and 15., purchases made from the Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) are excluded from eVA.
2. In order to participate in this Contract and the MMCAP program, **a Participating Membership Application\* MUST** be completed, signed and faxed to Tina Mizelle, Statewide Contract Officer at 804-786-5413 for the state level approval. After the state level approval is complete, the application is forwarded to MMCAP for final approval. After final approval is complete, an email will be sent by MMCAP, to the requesting agency, outlining detailed instructions on website navigation, user id, password, and ordering procedures.

**IF AN APPLICATION FORM IS ALREADY ON FILE WITH THE STATE OF MINNESOTA (MMCAP) FOR YOUR FACILITY, ADDITIONAL FORMS DO NOT NEED TO BE COMPLETED. A membership application form can be obtained by visiting the MMCAP website at [www.mmcap.org](http://www.mmcap.org).**
