Pursuant to the Division of Purchases and Supply, Agency Procurement and Surplus Property Manual, Chapter 14, Electronic Procurement, Section 14.9, Use of eVA and Exclusions, b., 14. and 15., purchases made from the Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) are excluded from eVA.

After the state level approval is complete, the application is forwarded to MMCAP for final approval. After final approval is complete, an email will be sent by MMCAP, to the requesting agency, outlining detailed instructions on website navigation, user id, password, and ordering procedures.
