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## **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **Purchase orders:** To the maximum extent possible, purchase orders shall be submitted to the contractor via the Commonwealth of Virginia's electronic procurement system, also known as eVA. The orders will be governed by this agreement and the terms and conditions contained in the separate agreement for participation in eVA executed by the contractor.
2. Inspection on delivery and approval of vendor's invoice is the responsibility of receiving state agency, Virginia city, county, town or political subdivision.
3. Any complaint as to quality, faulty or delinquent delivery, or violation of contract provisions by contractor shall be reported to the Division of Purchases and Supply for handling with the contractor. Preprinted forms (DGS-41-024), by which to facilitate the notification of the contractor and this office of complaints, are available from the Division of Purchases and Supply (786-8873).
5. **PRICE ESCALATION/DE-ESCALATION:** Price adjustments may be permitted for changes in the contractor's cost of materials. The Producer's Price Index PPI index for commodities 0661 (laminating resins), 662 (Thermoplastic resins), 2822 (plastic materials & resins), 1089 (metal foil/leaf), paper or other similar published commodity type data as applicable to the manufacture of reflective license plate materials may be used as a guide. No price increases will be authorized for three (3) years from date of contract award (May 1, 2004) but annual price adjustments may occur thereafter for the remaining two (2) year period of the contract.

The application of PPI increases and such costs passed to 3M from their suppliers for the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the contract (May 1, 2007) would cover the period from the date of contract award. Any additional price increases for the 5<sup>th</sup> year of the contract beginning May 1, 2008, would include those increases which occurred during the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the contract. If no price increase occurs at the beginning of the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the contract, then the basis for any price increase effective at the beginning of the 5<sup>th</sup> year would cover the period from the beginning of contract award in 2004. However, "across the board" price decreases are subject to implementation at any time and shall be immediately conveyed to the Commonwealth.

Contractor shall give not less than 30 days advance notice of any price increase to the purchasing office. Any approved price changes will be effective only at the beginning of the calendar month following the end of the full 30 day notification period. The contractor shall document the amount and proposed effective date of any general change in the price of materials. Documentation shall be supplied with the contractor's request for increase which will verify the amount or percentage of increase which is being passed on to the contractor by the contractor's suppliers.

The purchasing office will notify the using agencies and contractor in writing of the effective date of any increase which it approves. However, the contractor shall fill all purchase orders received prior to the effective date of the price adjustment at the old contract prices. The contractor is further advised that decreases which affect the cost of materials are required to be communicated immediately to the purchasing office.

5. **MINIMUM ORDERS:** See the individual price sheets.
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- X. **eVA Business To Government Vendor Registration:** The eVA Internet electronic procurement solution, web site portal [www.eVA.virginia.gov](http://www.eVA.virginia.gov), streamlines and automates government purchasing activities in the Commonwealth. The eVA portal is the gateway for vendors to conduct business with state agencies and public bodies. All vendors desiring to provide goods and/or services to the Commonwealth shall participate in the eVA Internet e-procurement solution either through the eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service or eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service. ## DELIVERY

- 1) Delivery of prototype license plates (laminated to aluminum) for new license plate designs shall be made to DMV within 30 calendar days after receipt of the request from the DMV. A formal request will be made by DMV but a DMV purchase order will not be issued for the design work and prototype license plates because the Contractor provides them at no cost.
- 2) Delivery of rolls of graphic sheeting for approved, new license plate designs shall be made to VCE within 45 calendar days after verbal receipt of VCE's purchase order number.
- 3) Delivery of rolls of graphic sheeting for existing license plate designs shall be made within 45 calendar days after verbal receipt of VCE's purchase order number.
- 4) Delivery of rolls of standard issue sheeting shall be made to VCE within 45 calendar days after verbal receipt of VCE's purchase order numbers. The two standard issue sheeting types are 1) plain white with Virginia 400<sup>th</sup> anniversary text and 2) plain white with no graphics and no text.
- 5) Delivery of all opaque roll coat inks and any other production materials shall be made within 14 calendar days after verbal receipt of the request from VCE. Note: A VCE purchase order will not be issued for these materials because the Contractor provides them at no cost.
- 6) All deliveries shall be provided F.O.B. Destination to the COVA's designated point of delivery.
- 7) General Characteristics And Packaging: To ensure easy access and proper inventory control and to prevent roll damage due to double stacking, the reflective sheeting shall be shipped in bulk packages as follows:
  - a) Production run sequence numbers shall be affixed to the outside of each shipping package that corresponds to the materials contained therein;
  - b) Each roll shall be additionally designated by a core identifier stamped or affixed with a permanent label on the inside of each roll core;
  - c) A date of manufacture, as well as shipment date, shall be clearly visible on the outside of each bulk package.

The discounts associated for Tiers 3 and 4 do not qualify as ongoing pricing for subsequent orders that are less than these Tier 3 and Tier 4 quantities. Orders for Tier 3 and Tier 4 will also be single order single shipment to receive this discount. The pricing for subsequent orders of lesser quantities will revert to the Tier 2 pricing.
