## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Orders. Unless otherwise instructed by the Division of Purchases and Supply, all departments, institutions and agencies of the Commonwealth of Virginia may order items listed in this contract.
2. If this contract is authorized for use by localities (see line item 6, page 1), Virginia cities, counties, towns and political subdivisions may use their own form to order items listed in this contract.
3. The applicable contract number, federal employer identification number (FEI), and item number (for itemized contracts) must be shown on each purchase order.
4. Inspection on delivery and approval of vendor's invoice is the responsibility of receiving state agency, Virginia city, county, town or political subdivision.
5. Any complaint as to quality, faulty or delinquent delivery, or violation of contract provisions by contractor shall be reported to the Division of Purchases and Supply for handling with the contractor. Preprinted forms (DGS-41-024), by which to facilitate the notification of the contractor and this office of complaints, are available from the Division of Purchases and Supply web site at: [www.eva.state.va.us](http://www.eva.state.va.us).
6. Renewals. This contract may be renewed by the Commonwealth upon written agreement of both parties for four (4) successive one-year periods, under the terms of the current contract, and at a reasonable time (approximately 60 days) prior to the expiration.
7. Price Adjustments. During the current term of the contract, price escalation may be allowed every 365 days, if justified. The contract officer makes the decision to allow or deny a request for increase based upon the documentation submitted by the contractor. The contractor is required to pass on any price reductions immediately. **IMPORTANT!** All price increases must be approved by the contract officer. New Pricing lists will be posted to eVA. Contract Change Notices will be posted to eVA.
8. Repairs. Repaired equipment shall be returned to the sending agency or public body within 10 calendar days from the date Noland receives the equipment needing repair.
