This mandatory-use single agency term contract is established as a result of Invitation for Bids (IFB) # 546 dated August 29, 2005, and the IFB terms and conditions/special terms and conditions and Specifications are incorporated into this contract. DPS reference: eVA Procurement Folder number 495.

This purpose of this contract is to provide cotton batt for Commonwealth of Virginia, Department for the Blind and Vision Impaired-Virginia Industries for the Blind. The contract is a firm price per pound contract and orders will be placed on an "as-needed" basis by the agency.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. ORDERS:
 - A. Unless otherwise instructed by the Division of Purchases and Supply, all departments, institutions and agencies of the Commonwealth of Virginia will order items/services through eVA.
 - B. If this contract is authorized for use by localities, Virginia cities, counties, towns and political subdivisions, orders will be placed through eVA to the maximum extent possible.
2. The applicable contract number, federal employer identification number (FEI), and item number (for itemized contracts) must be shown on each purchase order.
3. Inspection on delivery and approval of vendor's invoice is the responsibility of receiving state agency, Virginia city, county, town or political subdivision.
4. Any complaint as to quality, faulty or delinquent delivery, or violation of contract provisions by contractor shall be reported to the Division of Purchases and Supply for handling with the contractor. Form (DGS-41-024), by which to facilitate the notification of the contractor and this office of complaints, is available from the Division of Purchases and Supply web site at www.eva.state.va.us.
5. Renewals. This contract has no (0) one-year remaining renewal options. The contract will be resolicited by the Commonwealth at a reasonable time (approximately 120 days) prior to the expiration.
6. Price Adjustments. During the current term of the contract, price escalation may be allowed every 180 days, if justified. The contract officer makes the decision to allow or deny a request for increase based upon the documentation submitted by the contractor. The contractor is required to pass on any price reductions immediately. **IMPORTANT!** All price increases must be approved by the contract officer. Contract users will be sent a Notice of Contract Change from this office as official notification of such changes, if approved.

ATTACHMENT B - SPECIFICATIONS

COTTON BATT

Cotton batt, stitched to nonwoven 100% polyester backing with channel stitched rows a minimum of 4 inches apart.

Cotton batt content: 100% cotton to consist of a new unused blend of 60% by weight linters and 40% weight cotton binders. Cotton shall be homogeneously treated with boric acid in volume to yield a minimum net 10% of the weight of cotton. Cotton shall be treated print to garning to insure uniform adhesion to cotton fibers. The treated batting shall not support combustion or smolder. Batting shall meet or exceed the Commonwealth of Virginia's State Fire Marshal's Code California Bureau of Home Furnishings Technical Bulletin 117, UFAC filling/padding component test method and ASTM D52-919. Batting shall be in compliance with the regulations of the Virginia State Fire Marshall's office.

Packaging: Industry standard of bale packaging with a protective wrapper. Each bale shall be properly labeled. Contractor shall be required to submit certification that materials bid are in conformance with specifications.

Sizes will be determined at the time of order placement. Typical sizes required are as follows:

76 x 104 x 6.50 oz/sq.ft.

COTTON FELT

SPECIFICATION: Cotton felt shall comply with the materials and performance requirements of Federal Specification No. V-M-96K dated February 15, 1990 and Interim Amendment No. 1 dated May 24, 1990, entitled "Mattress, Bed, Innerspring" for the grade specified. Cotton felt shall be treated with 10% dry boric acid by weight for fire retardancy. Cotton felt shall be furnished in rectangular bats, minimum of 48 in. wide x approximately 85 in. long, with weight per bat of approximately 10 lbs. to yield a 7/8" nominal loft thickness.

PACKAGING: Bats shall be folded twice, in thirds, and packaged in bundles consisting of 12 bats per bundle maximum. Bundles shall be securely wrapped in cardboard or plastic a properly strapped or tied. Packaging shall provide complete protection of bundles during shipment by common carrier and shall provide for stacking.

CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE: Contractor shall submit 2 copies of Certification of Compliance with each shipment invoice stating that the furnished product is in full compliance with the above specification for the Grade Felt specified and in full compliance with flammability standard.
